THE FLORIDA CRIMINAL PUNISHMENT CODE

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

The Committee on Rules to Implement the Florida Criminal Punishment Code was established on July 1, 1998, to consider and make recommendations to the Supreme Court of Florida on the adoption of procedural rules to implement the Florida Criminal Punishment Code. The term of the Committee is hereby extended to June 30, 2002, so that it may continue to perform the following tasks:

1. On an annual basis, evaluate the need for new or revised procedural rules to implement any changes to the Florida Criminal Punishment Code that have been enacted by the Florida Legislature.
2. In collaboration with the appropriate entities, develop and revise a sentencing scoresheet for use under the Criminal Punishment Code, and present it to the Supreme Court of Florida by June 15 of each year.
