## ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

The District Court of Appeal Budget Commission was created to oversee the preparation and implementation of the district court component of the judicial branch budget. The Commission is directly responsible for recommending budgeting and funding policies and procedures for the district court budgets, so that the funding requirements of each of the appellate courts can be adequately addressed while promoting statewide operational consistency. See Fla. R. Jud. Admin. 2.054.


