ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER


On January 2, 1996, then Chief Justice Stephen Grimes entered an Administrative Order setting forth the new composition of the Florida Court Education Council, which was based on recommendations from the council membership representing the various judicial education constituencies. In accordance with that composition plan and reflecting the changes in current conference officers and education committee membership, The Honorable Belvin Perry now replaces The Honorable Joseph Farina in the Council position reserved for the Chair of the Florida Conference of Circuit Judges; The Honorable Juan Ramirez now replaces The Honorable Carolyn Fulmer in the Council position reserved for the Associate Appellate Dean of the Florida College of Advanced Judicial Studies; and The Honorable Beth Bloom now replaces The Honorable Jeffrey Colbath in the Council position reserved for the President of the Conference of County Court Judges of Florida.
