IN RE: EMERGENCY ASSIGNMENT WITHIN THE TWELFTH AND
TWENTIETH JUDICIAL CIRCUITS

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

WHEREAS, it officially has been made known to me that it is necessary to the dispatch of business of the Twelfth and Twentieth Judicial Circuit Courts of Florida;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Barbara J. Pariente, under authority vested in me as Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Florida, under article V, section 2 of the Constitution of Florida, and the rules of this Court promulgated thereunder, do hereby authorize the Honorable Robert B. Bennett, Jr., Chief Judge of the Twelfth Judicial Circuit Court of Florida, for a period of time ending at 5:00 p.m. on August 20, 2004, to act on any arrest warrants involving any violation of probation in which the Circuit Court of the Twelfth Judicial Circuit of Florida retains jurisdiction due to the closure of courts within the Twelfth and Twentieth Judicial Circuits of Florida. The chief judge can seek an extension of this time period if circumstance so warrant.
