IN RE: TASK FORCE ON JUDICIAL BRANCH PLANNING

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

Article III, section 19, of the Constitution of the State of Florida requires the judicial branch to develop a long-range plan. Furthermore, strategic and operational planning provide an opportunity for the judicial branch to assess the major trends and challenges confronting our court system and formulate a sound, thoughtful, systematic approach for addressing those challenges.

In 1995, the Judicial Management Council was charged with developing a comprehensive strategic planning process for the Judicial Branch. The Florida State Courts System's first comprehensive long-range strategic plan, *Taking Bearings, Setting Courts: The Long-Range Strategic Plan for the Florida Judicial Branch*, was adopted in 1998. A series of biennial operational plans that identify specific, short-term objectives to advance the goals of the long-range plan have also been developed.

The planning duties described in rule 2.125(b)(2), Rules of Judicial Administration, shall continue to be performed by the Task Force on Judicial Branch Planning, which is hereby re-established for a term to expire on June 30, 2008. The Task Force shall perform the following tasks:

1. Finalize a proposed operational plan for the period of 2006-2008.
2. Review and update the issues, desired outcomes, goals, and strategies in the long-range strategic plan. The updated long-range strategic plan shall be submitted to the Court before July 1, 2007.


