ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER


On April 3, 2007, The Honorable Steve Leifman was appointed to serve as Special Advisor to the Chief Justice on Criminal Justice and Mental Health (hereinafter "Special Advisor"). The role of the Special Advisor is to provide recommendations to the Chief Justice that are designed to produce tangible, identifiable, long-term solutions to the problems associated with untreated mental illnesses or co-occurring substance use disorders or both.

Based upon funding considerations and budgetary cycles, the original term of the Special Advisor was established for a period that will expire on June 30, 2007. The Florida Legislature has approved state funding that extends financial support of the Special Advisor's leadership role, for the period of July 1, 2007, through June 30, 2008.

Accordingly, Judge Leifman's term as Special Advisor is hereby extended through June 30, 2008. The Special Advisor shall continue to utilize the directives established in Administrative Order AOSC07-11, dated April 3, 2007.


The Court expresses appreciation to The Florida Bar Foundation for providing initial financial support for the Special Advisor's role.
