IN RE: DISTRICT COURT OF APPEAL BUDGET COMMISSION

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

The District Court of Appeal Budget Commission was created to oversee the preparation and implementation of the district court component of the judicial branch budget. The Commission is directly responsible for recommending budgeting and funding policies and procedures for the district court budgets, so that the funding requirements of each of the intermediate appellate courts can be adequately addressed while promoting statewide operational consistency.

The terms of the Commission members expired on June 30, 2007. The following appointments are effective as of July 1, 2007, nunc pro tunc.

In accordance with rule 2.235(e)(1), Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, the following chief judges shall serve on the Commission through June 30, 2009:


Furthermore, in accordance with rule 2.235(e)(1), Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, the marshal of each district court of appeal shall serve as a nonvoting participant on the Commission.

The terms of the Chair and Vice Chair of the Commission have also expired. Chief Judge Stevan T. Northcutt is appointed to serve as Chair, and Chief Judge Edwin Browning, Jr. is appointed to serve as Vice Chair until June 30, 2009.

The Honorable Carolyn Fulmer completed her regular term of service on the Commission effective June 30, 2007, and is hereby designated to serve as the Chair Emeritus until June 30, 2009. As Chair Emeritus, Judge Fulmer will be a nonvoting member of the Commission, shall be advised of all Commission meetings and authorized to attend at state expense, and will share with the Commission the benefit of her knowledge and expertise on district court funding issues and perform such other tasks as may be assigned by the Commission Chair.


