IN RE: JUDICIAL MANAGEMENT COUNCIL

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

On February 9, 2012, in In re: Implementation of Judicial Branch Governance Study Group Recommendations – Amendments to the Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, Case No. SC11-1374, the Supreme Court recreated the Judicial Management Council as a focused advisory body to assist the chief justice and the Court, as specified in rule 2.225, Florida Rules of Judicial Administration.

The Court also directed that voting members, other than the chief justice, each be appointed for an initial term of either two or four years, with the terms staggered to ensure continuity and experience on the Council, and for four-year terms thereafter. Accordingly, the following persons are appointed or reappointed to serve on the Council for a term to expire on June 30, 2018:


