IN RE: MEDIATOR ETHICS ADVISORY COMMITTEE

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

In accordance with the Florida Rules for Certified and Court-Appointed Mediators, a panel was appointed in 1994 to provide written advisory opinions to mediators concerning interpretations of the rules and guidance on standards of conduct. 
