IN RE: UNIFORM CASE REPORTING IMPLEMENTATION

## ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

This order is issued to address new and revised requests by clerks of court for extensions to the Uniform Case Reporting deadlines that are established in In re: Uniform Case Reporting Implementation, Fla. Admin. Order No. AOSC18-18 (June 22, 2018) in support of the Uniform Case Reporting system required by In re: Uniform Case Reporting Requirements, Fla. Admin. Order No. AOSC16-15 (April 27, 2016).

The requests for an extension of time submitted since June 22, 2018, are resolved as follows:

1. The requests by the clerks of court for Clay (June 25, 2018), Monroe (June 22, 2018), and St. Lucie (June 22, 2018) counties are hereby granted.

The revised request for an extension to the circuit civil reporting deadline submitted by the clerk of court for Pasco County (June 21, 2018) through November 2018 on behalf of the clerks of court for Alachua, Baker, Bradford, Calhoun, Columbia, DeSoto, Dixie, Franklin, Gilchrist, Glades, Gulf, Hamilton, Hardee, Hendry, Hernando, Highlands, Holmes, Jackson, Jefferson, Lafayette, Levy, Liberty, Madison, Manatee, Marion, Martin, Nassau, Okeechobee, Putnam, Santa Rosa, Sumter, Suwannee, Taylor, Union, Wakulla, Walton, and Washington counties is conditionally granted, contingent upon the submission of a request by each clerk of court. Requests should be submitted no later than July 13, 2018, to the State Courts
