





A. Administrative Law Practice Subcommittee — Chair, E. Jonathan Whitney

The Subcommittee has three issues before it:

- (1) Whether an amendment is necessary to Rule 9.190(e)(1). At the September, 2006 meeting of the ACRC, the Subcommittee proposed an amendment to Rule 9.310(b)(2) which was passed by the ACRC. In light of various comments received by the ACRC, the ACRC reviewed the issue again at its September, 2007 meeting, declined to revisit the issue, and reaffirmed its recommendation of the amendment. During those discussions in September, 2007, the question was raised whether further amendment to Fla. R. App. P. 9.190(e)(1) was necessary as a result of the amendment. After studying the issue, the Subcommittee does not think that further amendment is necessary and suggests no action by the ACRC.

The oral status report was identical to the Administrative Law Practice Subcommittee Written Report Submitted December 18, 2007 and was as follows:

The Administrative Law Practice Subcommittee met by telephone conference on November 15, 2007, at 2:15 p.m. Those who participated included Vice-Chair Kelly O'Keefe, Dave Miller, Allen Watts, and Chair Jon Whitney.

The agenda items set forth below were discussed. Regarding Item (1), in light of the proposed amendment to Fla. R. App. P. 9.310(b)(2), which was approved by the full Committee at the last ACRC meeting, Dave Miller prepared the attached analysis [*Editor's note: this analysis may be found at App. H-9-10, of the Committee's Amended Triennial Report*], which concludes that further amendments to Fla. R. App. P. 9.190(e) are not necessary, and the quorum agreed with Dave's analysis....
