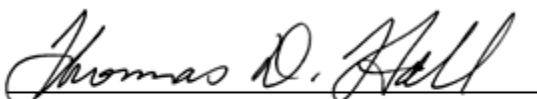
Respondent's Motion for Rehearing and Motion to Clarify Supreme Court Order dated October 15, 2010, are hereby denied.
