The Clerk of the Fourth District Court of Appeal shall file the original record which shall be properly indexed and paginated on or before April 28, 2008. The record shall include the briefs filed in the district court separately indexed.

NO CONTINUANCES WILL BE GRANTED EXCEPT UPON A SHOWING OF EXTREME HARDSHIP.


