AMENDED VERIFIED MOTION FOR ADMISSION PRO HAC VICE

Karen Gievers respectfully moves this Court, pursuant to Fla. R. App. P. 9.440(a) and Fla. R. Jud. Admin. 2.061, for leave for Attorney Steven K. Green to appear as counsel for Amicus Baptist Joint Committee, et al., in the above-referenced appeals. In support of their amended motion, movant states as follows:

1. Attorney Green is an active member in good standing of the bar of the state of Minnesota, and of the following federal courts: United States Supreme Court; United States Courts of Appeals for the Second, Fourth, Fifth, Eighth, Ninth, and Eleventh Circuits; and the United States District

Court for the Southern District of Texas. A certificate of good standing in the Minnesota Bar was attached to the original verified motion for admission pro hac vice.

2. Attorney Green has previously, within the preceding five years, sought and been granted leave to appear in the trial court proceedings below on behalf of Appellees in Holmes, et al. v. Bush, et al, Case No. 99-3370 (2nd Judicial Circuit) (Nov. 16, 1999), and in prior appeals in this matter: Bush, et al. v. Holmes, et al, No. 1D00-1121/1150; McShane, et al. v. Holmes, et al., No. 1D01-2220 (Aug. 14, 2001); Bush, et al. v. Holmes, et al., No. 1D02-3160/3163/3199 (Oct. 28, 2002). As a result of a change in employment, Attorney Green withdrew as counsel on behalf of Appellees in 2004.

3. Attorney Green has not been disciplined in any jurisdiction during the preceding five years, nor are there any disciplinary proceedings pending against him.

4. Attorney Green files this amicus brief on behalf of: the Baptist Joint Committee; the Union for Reform Judaism; Americans for Religious Liberty; the National Council for Jewish Women; and the Jewish Labor Committee. His representation of these amici commenced on February 2, 2005.

5. Attorney Green has read all applicable provisions of the Florida Rules of Judicial Administration and the Rules Regulating The Florida Bar, and this motion complies with those rules.

6. Attorney Green will be associated in this representation with Karen Gievers, Esquire, an active member in good standing of The Florida Bar (Bar No. 262005). Ms. Gievers' address is 524 East College Avenue #2, Tallahassee, Florida 32301.

WHEREFORE, movant respectfully requests that the motion be granted and that leave to appear pro hac vice be allowed.



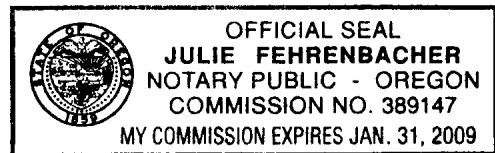
