Dear Mr. Hall:

I received the Court's order, dated June 28, 2006, relative to our client, the Honorable Richard H. Albritton, Jr. The consent agreement entered into with the Judicial Qualifications Commission called for a thirty-day suspension. Yet, the order references a suspension for a period of one month. I do not know if it is an issue, however, insofar as the suspension began immediately on June 28, 2006, we need guidance as to when Judge Albritton is eligible to resume his duties. It would appear, based upon the consent agreement that Judge Albritton could retake the bench on July 26, 2006. However, I am loathed to make assumptions in matters of such importance.

Please advise as to the Court's interpretation of the one-month suspension at your first opportunity. Your courtesy in this regard is greatly appreciated.
