**MOTION OF JOE ANDERSON, JR. FOR LEAVE
TO FILE *AMICUS CURIAE* BRIEF ON
BEHALF OF RESPONDENT**

AND

**MOTION FOR ADDITIONAL
TEN DAYS TO SERVE BRIEF**

(No Objection by Respondent; Petitioner does Object)

Pursuant to Rule 9.370(a), Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure, undersigned counsel respectfully requests this Court to grant leave to Joe Anderson, Jr. to file an *amicus curiae* brief on behalf of Respondent. In addition, pursuant to Rule 9.370(c), Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure, undersigned counsel requests an additional ten days to serve the *amicus* brief on behalf of the Respondent.

Joe Anderson, Jr. has an interest in the issues presented in this case because he is the Petitioner in *Joe Anderson, Jr. vs. Gannett Co., Inc., et al.* (Case No.

SC06-2174), which is set for oral argument on March 6, 2008, along with this case. Anderson's issue relates to the statute of limitations applicable to a false light claim. The *Jews for Jesus* case involves the future viability of the false light cause of action.

The *amicus* brief will assist the court by addressing certain issues related to false light invasion of privacy and will address The Florida Senate *Interim Project Report 2008-144 (November 2007)* entitled "Analysis of Cause of Action for False Light Invasion of Privacy."

Undersigned counsel respectfully requests a ten day extension to serve the *amicus* brief, up to and including, December 13, 2007. Pursuant to Rule 9.370(c), the "court may grant leave for later service, specifying the time within which an opposing party may respond." Since the case will not be argued until March, the additional time will not delay the case.

Counsel for the Respondent, Barry Silver, consents to this Motion and the extension. Mathew Staver, counsel for Petitioner objects to both the request to file an *amicus curiae* brief and the request for an extension.
