
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

Upon consideration of concerns raised by the District Courts of Appeal regarding the specific implementation of electronic filing through the Florida Courts E-Filing Portal (Portal) and the appellate courts' new internal case management system, eFACTS, and in compliance with this Court's Revised Opinion in *In re: Amendments to the Florida Rules of Civil Procedure, the Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, the Florida Rules of Criminal Procedure, the Florida Probate Rules, the Florida Small Claims Rules, the Florida Rules of Juvenile Procedure, the Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure, and the Florida Family Law Rules of Procedure – Electronic Filing*, 102 So. 3d 451 (Fla. 2012), this Court hereby authorizes the Chief Judge of each District Court of Appeal to issue administrative orders relating to the Clerk to Clerk page within the Portal, including the case documents filed at the trial court that initiate the appeals. These


administrative orders may include required formats deemed necessary for the smooth and effective transition of these Clerk to Clerk documents within both the Portal and eFACTS at the district courts of appeal. All such orders must be copied to this Court via the Clerk of Court. Copies shall also be provided to The Honorable Lisa Taylor Munyon, Chair, Florida Courts Technology Commission, The Honorable Stevan T. Northcutt, Chair, Appellate Courts Technology Commission, and The Honorable Tim Smith, Chair, Florida Courts E-Filing Authority Board.

This order is effective immediately and remains in effect until further order of this Court.
