IN RE: FLORIDA COMMISSION ON ACCESS TO CIVIL JUSTICE

## ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

The purpose of the Florida Commission on Access to Civil Justice is to study the remaining unmet civil legal needs of disadvantaged, low income, and moderate income Floridians. The Commission encompasses the viewpoints of multiple constituencies and stakeholders and is not limited to those of any one particular institution. The Commission considers Florida's legal assistance delivery system as a whole, including but not limited to staffed legal aid programs, resources and support for self-represented litigants, limited scope representation, pro bono services, innovative technology solutions, and other models and potential innovations. In carrying out its purpose, the Commission shall perform its responsibilities consistent with Long-Range Issue 2 (Enhance Access to Justice and Court Services) of The Long-Range Strategic Plan for the Florida Judicial Branch 2016-2021.

When the Commission was established as a standing commission in 2016, a system of staggered terms was instituted to avoid majority turnover in any year.

Some members' terms will expire on June 30, 2017. Accordingly, the following individuals are hereby appointed or reappointed to serve as members of the Commission for a term that begins on July 1, 2017, and expires on June 30, 2020:


