IN RE: FLORIDA COURTS TECHNOLOGY COMMISSION

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

The purpose of the Florida Courts Technology Commission is to oversee, manage, and direct the development and use of technology within the judicial branch under the direction of the Florida Supreme Court, as specified in Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.236.

When the Commission was re-established in 2010, a system of staggered terms was instituted to avoid majority turnover in any year. Some members' terms expire on June 30, 2017. In addition, Mr. Ken Nelson has resigned from the Commission due to his retirement. The Court expresses its appreciation for the exemplary service provided by Mr. Nelson during his tenure on the Commission.

To accomplish the continuing tasks of modernizing court processes through automation, expand self-service options for court users, as well as safeguarding the security, integrity, and confidentiality of court data and technology systems, the


