COMMENTS OF HENRY P. TRAWICK, JR.

Respondent HENRY P. TRAWICK, JR. comments on the proposed changes to the probate rules in this proceeding as follows:

1. Respondent is a lawyer in good standing with The Florida Bar.
2. The rule change to Rules 5.120(b) and 5.200(c) show only the year of birth of the persons alleged to be minors. Both of these rules deal with proceedings that may extend a significant period of time and the date of birth may be a significant item for future proceedings. Persons involved in the future proceedings may not know the date of birth. It may be an important factor in determining how they deal with those persons in the future proceedings. The date of birth of any person is not a significant privacy matter.
3. Respondent does not believe the change should be made in these probate rules because it deprives possible opposing parties from deciding how to handle future proceedings concerning those who were minors at the inception.
