The uncontested report of the referee is approved and respondent is suspended from the practice of law for ninety days, effective nunc pro tunc, November 2, 2008.


Respondent is further directed to attend The Florida Bar's Trust Accounting Workshop under the terms and conditions set forth in the report and the consent judgment.
