PETITIONER'S BRIEF ON JURISDICTION

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INTRODUCTION

The Petitioner, United Automobile Insurance Company, was the Defendant in the trial court, the Appellant before the District Court and will be referred to as United Auto. The Respondent, Millennium Radiology, LLC, a/a/o Luis Rivas, were the Plaintiff below, the Appellee before the District Court and will be referred to as Hallandale Beach. The symbol "A." will designate the appendix to this brief.

STATEMENT OF THE CASE AND FACTS

The Fourth District affirmed the ruling of the county court based on its earlier opinion in *Kingsway Amigo Ins. Co. v. Ocean Health, Inc.*, 63 So.3d 63 (Fla. 4th DCA 2011), *petition for discretionary review pending in SC11-1581*. (A-1). This petition then followed.

B.J.F.*, 530 So.2d 286, 288 n. 3 (Fla. 1988).

ARGUMENT

THIS COURT WOULD HAVE JURISDICTION IN THE INSTANT CASE IF THIS COURT EXERCISES ITS JURISDICTION TO REVIEW *KINGSWAY AMIGO INS. CO. V. OCEAN HEALTH, INC.*, 63 SO.3D 63 (FLA. 4TH DCA 2011).
