
Upon reinstatement, respondent is further placed on probation for two years under the terms and conditions set forth in the report and the consent judgment.

Judgment is entered for The Florida Bar, 651 East Jefferson Street, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-2300, for recovery of costs from David Edward Evans in the amount of \$3,161.06, for which sum let execution issue.
