

Petitioners have filed a "Petition for Writ(s) of Mandamus, Quo Warranto and/or Petition to Invoke All Writs Jurisdiction Directed to the Third District Court of Appeal." To the extent petitioners seek a writ of quo warranto, the petition is hereby denied. To the extent petitioners seek a writ of mandamus, the petition is hereby denied because petitioners have failed to show a clear legal right to the relief requested. See Huffman v. State, 813 So. 2d 10, 11 (Fla. 2000). To the extent petitioners seek to invoke all writs jurisdiction, the petition is dismissed for lack of jurisdiction because petitioners have failed to cite an independent basis that would allow the Court to exercise its all writs authority and no such basis is apparent on the face of the petition. See Williams v. State, 913 So. 2d 541, 543-44 (Fla. 2005) and St. Paul Title Ins. Corp. v. Davis, 392 So. 2d 1304, 1305 (Fla. 1980).
