Respondent is further directed to attend the next scheduled session of The Florida Bar's Ethics School held in his geographical area under the terms and conditions set forth in the report and consent judgment.

Judgment is entered for The Florida Bar, 651 East Jefferson Street, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-2300, for recovery of costs from Stanley Howard Orner in the amount of \$2,337.14, for which sum let execution issue.


