The Florida Bar having filed on November 17, 2006, Notice of Judgment of Guilt, it is ordered that Basem Soliman is suspended from The Florida Bar pursuant to 3-7.2(f) of the Rules Regulating the Florida Bar, and it is further

ORDERED that this suspension shall be effective thirty days from November 17, 2006, so that respondent can close out his practice and protect the interests of existing clients. If respondent notifies this Court in writing that he is no longer practicing and does not need the thirty days to protect existing clients, this Court will enter an order making the suspension effective immediately. Respondent shall accept no new business from the date this order is filed until the suspension expires.


The above matter has been referred to the Chief Judge of the Seventh Judicial Circuit for the appointment of a referee pursuant to rule 3-7.2(h).
