ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

In In re: Implementation of Judicial Branch Governance Study Group Recommendations – Amendments to the Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, 119 So. 3d 1211 (Fla. 2012), the Supreme Court recreated the Judicial Management Council as a focused advisory body to assist the chief justice and the Court, as specified in rule 2.225, Florida Rules of Judicial Administration.

The Court also directed that voting members, other than the chief justice, each be appointed for an initial term of either two or four years, with the terms staggered to ensure continuity and experience on the Council, and for four-year terms thereafter. Some Council members' terms expired on June 30, 2018. Accordingly, the following persons are appointed or reappointed to serve on the Council for a term that expires on June 30, 2022:

The Honorable Charles T. Canady shall serve as Chair of the Council through June 30, 2020. Additionally, Ms. Patricia Jameson shall continue to serve as a nonvoting member of the Council in the position reserved for the state courts administrator.
