

In light of the above, the Commission finds that the interests of justice and public welfare will be adequately served by the following discipline, which it hereby recommends to this Court:

- (1) Public Reprimand to be delivered personally to Respondent before the Supreme Court of Florida;
- (2) Respondent's participation in psychological/behavioral therapy with an emphasis on sensitivity training by a qualified health care professional until such professional has certified, in writing, that such treatment is no longer necessary; and
- (3) Public apology to the citizens of Broward County in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A.
