IN RE: APPELLATE COURT TECHNOLOGY COMMITTEE

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

The purpose of the Appellate Court Technology Committee, which is a standing committee of the Florida Courts Technology Commission, is to provide technical guidance and consultation to the Florida Courts Technology Commission regarding information systems development and operational policies and procedures relating to automation in the district courts of appeal, as specified in Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.236.

In carrying out that purpose, the Appellate Court Technology Committee shall perform its rule-based responsibilities consistent with the *2016-2021 Long-Range Strategic Plan for the Florida Judicial Branch*, specifically with regard to effectuating Goal 4.2 (Safeguard the security, integrity, and confidentiality of court data and technology systems) and Goal 4.3 (Create a compatible technology infrastructure to improve case management and meet the needs of the judicial branch and court users) of the strategic plan.

The committee members' terms expired on June 30, 2019. In accordance with Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.236(g)(3), the following persons are hereby appointed for a term that expires on June 30, 2022:




