IN RE: COMMITTEE ON ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION
RULES AND POLICY

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

Chapter 44, Florida Statutes, requires the Supreme Court of Florida to establish rules of practice and procedure for court-ordered mediation and court-ordered arbitration. The Court established the Committee on Alternative Dispute Resolution Rules and Policy to assist the Court in exercising its powers and performing its duties under the statute. This administrative order reappoints six members and appoints one new member to the committee.

To avoid majority turnover in any year, members of the committee are appointed to staggered terms and no member may serve more than nine years. The following persons are reappointed to serve a three-year term that expires on June 30, 2022:



Ms. Dubow's term, which expires on June 30, 2021:


