IN RE: PARENTING COORDINATOR REVIEW BOARD

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

The Parenting Coordinator Review Board was established by the Court in 2016 to perform investigations and adjudications of grievances against qualified and court-appointed parenting coordinators. The ten-member Board is responsible for enforcing the ethical standards of the Rules for Qualified and Court-Appointed Parenting Coordinators and in that role reviews grievances, determines probable cause, conducts hearings, and imposes sanctions, if appropriate. Members serve staggered, four-year terms and no member shall serve more than three terms.

A vacancy exists on the Board due to the resignation of Ms. Bonnie Marmor. The following individual is appointed to complete the remainder of Ms. Marmor's term on the Board, which expires on June 30, 2020:
