IN RE: FLORIDA COMMISSION ON ACCESS TO CIVIL JUSTICE

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

The purpose of the Florida Commission on Access to Civil Justice is to study the remaining unmet civil legal needs of disadvantaged, low-income, and moderate-income Floridians. When the Commission was re-established in 2016, a system of staggered terms was instituted to avoid majority turnover in any year. Some members' term on the Commission expired on June 30, 2019. 


Additionally, The Honorable Olin Shinholser is designated to serve as Chair
