## ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

A critical element in the resolution of all jury trials in Florida is the instruction of the jury by a judge as to the law and processes to be applied in connection with the decisions to be made in the case. The purpose of the Committee on Standard Jury Instructions—Contract and Business Cases is to propose recommendations to the Court regarding changes to the standard jury instructions in contract and business cases in response to legislative enactments, judicial decisions or other events that affect the presentation of cases to juries. The committee is also charged with reviewing the existing standard instructions for




