## ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

This order is issued to address new and revised requests by clerks of court for extensions to the Portable Document Format for Archiving (PDF/A) deadline established in *In Re: Filing Electronic Court Documents Standards and Document Storage and Backup of Electronic Records Standards*, Fla. Admin. Order No. AOSC19-23, corrected (June 10, 2019).


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1. By letters dated May 17, 2021, and April 28, 2021, as modified on May 28, 2021, respectively, the Clerks of Court for Brevard and Monroe counties requested an extension of the deadline established in AOSC19-23. Although AOSC19-23 directed that such requests be submitted by December 31, 2020, this amended administrative order is issued to grant Brevard County an extension until December 31, 2021, and to grant Monroe County an extension until June 1, 2022.


The requests for an extension of time received are resolved as follows:

1. The clerks of court for Bay, Brevard, Charlotte, Citrus, Escambia, Indian River, Leon, Martin, Okaloosa, Osceola, St. Johns, St. Lucie, Sarasota, and Volusia counties are hereby granted an extension until December 31, 2021.
2. The clerks of court for Baker, Bradford, Calhoun, Collier, Columbia, DeSoto, Dixie, Duval, Flagler, Franklin, Gilchrist, Glades, Gulf, Hamilton, Hardee, Hendry, Hernando, Highlands, Holmes, Jackson, Jefferson, Lafayette, Lake, Levy, Liberty, Madison, Manatee, Marion, Monroe, Nassau, Okeechobee, Palm Beach, Pasco, Polk, Putnam, Santa Rosa, Sumter, Suwannee, Taylor, Union, Wakulla, Walton, and Washington counties are hereby granted until June 1, 2022.
